Senator McCain;

This past Friday my wife and I were the victims of vandalism and theft as thieves smashed our car window and stole my wife's small purse from under the car seat. They did it because they could.

Even though we parked close to the entrance of Wal-Mart in Apache Junction, in direct line to the security camera, the opportunity to commit a crime was greater than the threat of being caught.

I am in receipt of your proxy letter of March 26, 2004 in which it was requested to provide copies of correspondence and any supporting documents, a description of my problem and what action I specifically request of your office.

Enclosed with this letter is a compact disk containing 403 documents of evidence: nearly well over a thousand pages of specific evidence detailing, without a doubt, the crimes listed in the documents numbered #35 & #330 dated January 13, 2004. The investigation report contained in the CD presentation is specific and to the point.

Document #403 is the correspondence improperly sent to the accused by Senator Graham's staff without permission.

I have been the victim of a series of federal offenses, carried out under the color of law and have documented every single one of them. The USDOJ did not do their job and ignored the evidence. The FBI did not do their job and confused and ignored the evidence. The FCC did not do their job and have stalled their investigation. The EEOC did not do their job and have handed a charge case to the accused to judge, where it was predictably dismissed.

All I am asking of you and your office is to compel the agencies of the Federal Government to do their job so as to preclude the continued belief that crimes can be committed, as the threat of being caught is less than the opportunity and motive to commit the crimes.

Enclosed is also the completed Privacy Act Consent Form provided by your office and a copy of the proxy letter.

My wife and I both respectfully request a meeting with Senator McCain at his convenience, after a proper review of the enclosed material has been completed.

There is deep and rampant corruption within this government. It will stop. If that takes two people doing alone, then so be it. If it takes one courageous Senator and two people to get it done, our country would be in his debt.

I look forward to a timely reply to this letter and a timely response to the request and documents provided in this letter.
