Description: ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS

APPLICANT SUBMITS THAT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SECTION 1.1307(A) DO NOT APPLY IN THE LICENSE RENEWAL CONTEXT. SPECIFICALLY, BOTH THE PLAIN LANGUAGE OF SECTION 1.1307 AND ITS HISTORY CONTEMPLATE APPLICATION OF SUBSECTION (A) TO ADDRESS THE ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, NOT LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS. THE COMMISSION MADE CLEAR LESS THAN EIGHT MONTHS AGO THAT THE INITIATION OF INTERIM IN-BAND, ON-CHANNEL (IBOC) BROADCAST OPERATIONS IS CATEGORICALLY EXCLUDED FROM ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESSING UNDER 47 C.F.R. SECTION 1.1306 BECAUSE SUCH IBOC OPERATIONS 'NORMALLY WILL

REQUIRE NO CONSTRUCTION OR TOWER LIGHTING.' DIGITAL AUDIO BROADCASTING SYSTEMS AND THEIR IMPACT ON THE TERRESTRIAL RADIO BROADCAST SERVICE, 17 FCC RCD 19990, 20004 (2002). BECAUSE BROADCAST LICENSE RENEWALS ENTAIL NO CONSTRUCTION OR TOWER LIGHTING, THE SAME CONCLUSION, I.E., CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION APPLIES. AS WITH IBOC, A CERTIFICATION OF 'COMPLIANCE WITH RF EXPOSURE STANDARDS SATISFIES ANY ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS.' ID. SEE IN RE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT OF 1969, 39 FED REG. 43834 (DEC. 19, 1974); IN RE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT OF 1969, 40 FED. REG. 53391 (NOV. 18, 1975); AMENDING ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS TO TAKE COGNIZANCE OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS 11988 (FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT) AND 11990 (PROTECTION OF WETLANDS), 42 FED. REG. 59754 (NOV. 21, 1977); SEE ALSO RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION TO CONSIDER BIOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF RADIOFREQUENCY RADIATION WHEN AUTHORIZING THE USE OF RADIOFREQUENCY DEVICES; POTENTIAL EFFECTS OF A REDUCTION IN THE ALLOWABLE LEVEL OF RADIOFREQUENCY RADIATION ON FCC AUTHORIZED COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT, 57 RR 2D 1280 (MAR. 14, 1985); AMENDMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RULES RESPONSE TO NEW REGULATIONS ISSUED BY THE COUNCIL ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, 60 RR 2D 13 (MAR. 26, 1986); AMENDMENT OF THE COMMISSION'S ENVIRONMENTAL RULES, 65 RR 2D 116 (AUG. 16, 1988).
