FEDERAL DISCRIMINATION AND RETALIATION LAW SUIT FILED

Phoenix, AZ (May 3, 2004) Today, a law suit has been filed against L.M. Communications Inc., a Kentucky corporation, for discharge, retaliation with malice in reckless disregard of the law against L.M. Communications Inc., a Kentucky corporation.

Five separate protected activities are documented.

During 2002, Plaintiff, Lee Kent Hempfling (Lee) was discharged against for attempting to hire a black female, conducting company investigations and supporting the activities of the company. She settled an EEOC charge with the company. She worked for music R&B Rhythmic Oldies station and argued the case.

The company has testified to the EEOC that the reason for the discharge of Lee Kent Hempfling was Program Director for (WCOO, the station).
